MEANING OF "ISLAM"

ISLAM = Finding Peace and Salvation through submission to God's Will

MUSLIM = One who strives to submit their will to the Will of God

Now new or different from Biblical teachings:

21. Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

[Matthew 7:21]

9. After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

We believe in that which has been revealed to us and revealed to you, and our God and your God is One, and to Him do we submit".


(Qur'an 29:46)

WHO WAS MOHAMMAD?

Descendant of Abraham through Abraham's first son Ishmael





WHO WAS MOHAMMAD?

- Born into a noble family in Mecca, Saudi Arabia, in 570 C.E.
- Died in 632 CE at the age of 63
- Was a thoughtful youth who worked as a shepherd
- He rejected the immoral customs of his people, who had become steeped in idolatry
- His character earned him the nickname 'AL-AMEEN = The Trustworthy'
- Mohammed was unlettered could not read nor write.
- Received his first revelation from God at 40 through the Angel Gabriel which continued for 23 years (The Quran)
- Like other prophets, he preformed miracles, by God's Permission, but he taught that his greatest miracle is the Quran and called it a "Lasting Miracle".
- In the ranking of the 100 Top Ranked people of all time, by Michael Hart, Muhammed ranked first.



SOURCES OF ISLAM

Previous Scriptures
 were sources of Islam but now many teachings are superseded by
 the Quran (eg the Sabbath, etc).

CORE BELIEFS OF MUSLIMS

- 1. Belief in One God
- 2. Belief in the Angels
- 3. Belief in God's revealed books
- 4. Belief in prophets and messengers of God
- 5. Beliefs in the Day of Judgement
- 6. Belief in predestination and foreknowledge



Pillars Of Islam

The 'Five Pillars' of Islam are the foundation of Muslim life:

- a. Faith or belief in the Oneness of God and b. the finality of the prophethood of Muhammad;
- 2. Establishment of the 5 daily prayers;
- 3. Compulsory almsgiving to the needy (Muslim and non Muslim) known as Zakat;
- 4. Fasting the Month of Ramadan;
- 5. Pilgrimage to Makkah for those who are physically and financially able.

(All pillars become a duty for males and females at the age of puberty)

IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES

NO COMPULSION IN RELIGION

"Let there be no compulsion in religion.

Truth stands out clear from Error.

Whoever rejects evil and believes in God
has grasped the most trustworthy hand-hold,
that never breaks.

And God hears and knows all things."

(The Holy Quran, Chapter 2 (The Heifer). Verse 256)

FREEDOM OF RELIGION AND LIFE

"If it had been God's Plan
they would not have worshiped other things besides gods:
and We have <u>not</u> appointed you
as a guardian over them
nor are you set over them
to dispose of their affairs".

The Holy Quran Chapter 6, (Al-Anaam) - Verses 107



THE SAVING OF LIFE

"... We ordained for the Children of Israel that if anyone slew a person unless it be for murder or for spreading mischief in the land it would be as if they killed the whole of mankind: and if anyone saved a life it would be as if they saved the life of the whole of mankind. 

- Most Muslims in Australia are just beginning to meet each other.





PRACTICAL OBSERVATIONS

- Islamic greeting is "Assalamu Alaykum" (means peace be upon you in Arabic)
- Like Orthodox Jews some Muslims may not shake hands with the opposite gender (limited physical contact)
- Muslims may lower their gaze when speaking with the opposite gender



IMPACT OF WORLD EVENTS ON LOCAL MUSLIMS 1

Serious impacts on the Muslim Community:

- Identity challenge to choose parts of identity (eg. Aussie, Muslim, Arab, etc)
- Increase problems in schools (bullying and vilification etc) Learning Distraction
- Impact on Aspirations. Lessened hopes that there is a future in Australia
- Increased vilification generally in Media, street etc.
- Increased suspicion, fear and hate. Increase "Us and Them" attitudes.
- Increase in unemployment
- Decrease in household Income.



IMPACT OF WORLD EVENTS ON LOCAL MUSLIMS 2

Serious impacts on the Muslim Community (Continued):

- Decrease in health and levels of treatment and care (reduced exercise, stress, neglected health issues etc)
- Mental health issues. Increased depression, anger and anxieties.
- Decrease in personal safety and security. Attacks on persons and property
- People may be Fear of travel especially to unfamiliar territory.
- Decreased ability to "integrate".
- Decrease in opportunity to meeting people, socialising and making friends
- Increased incidence of discrimination and inadequate legal recourse assistance
- Lack of recreation programs and opportunities (especially for women and youth).



ISSUES RELATED TO PRAYERS


- 5 daily prayers have times set within time ranges
- In emergencies, Prayers may be combined and shortened.
- Prayers only take a short time (about 5 minutes)
- Need access to a safe space to pray
- May need access to washing facilities for ablution (may involve washing and / or wiping hands and arms to the elbow, face, and feet)
- Friday Holy day for Muslims lunch time prayers important, especially for men



DIETARY ISSUES

- If Muslim are expected to participate in social functions, some Halal food should be provided.
- Halal food (Islamic equivalent of Kosher food)
 - Kosher food is OK
 - Vegetarian and Vegan is OK
 - Dairy is OK
 - Sea food is OK
 - Animal products (except dairy) should be from animals killed in a Kosher or Halal manner
 - No pig meat or by-products
 - No Alcohol
- Meat should be slaughtered in a halal way (purchased from Halal butcher)
- Halal food lists available from companies eg Kraft, Tip Top, Cadbury and others
- Halal food should be cooked and served separately from other food.
- It is a good idea to label the Halal, kosher or Vegetarian food as such so that it may be distinguished from other food
